Communicate with customers for project needs, start dates, and construction schedules. Work with vendors and subcontractors to receive quotes based on the project needs.

Create the Schedule of Values (SOV) for the projects awarded. Work closely with Project Managers to hand over the project i.e. price change orders, create cost codes for labor tracking, review vendor and subcontractor quotes, and review the scope of work.
